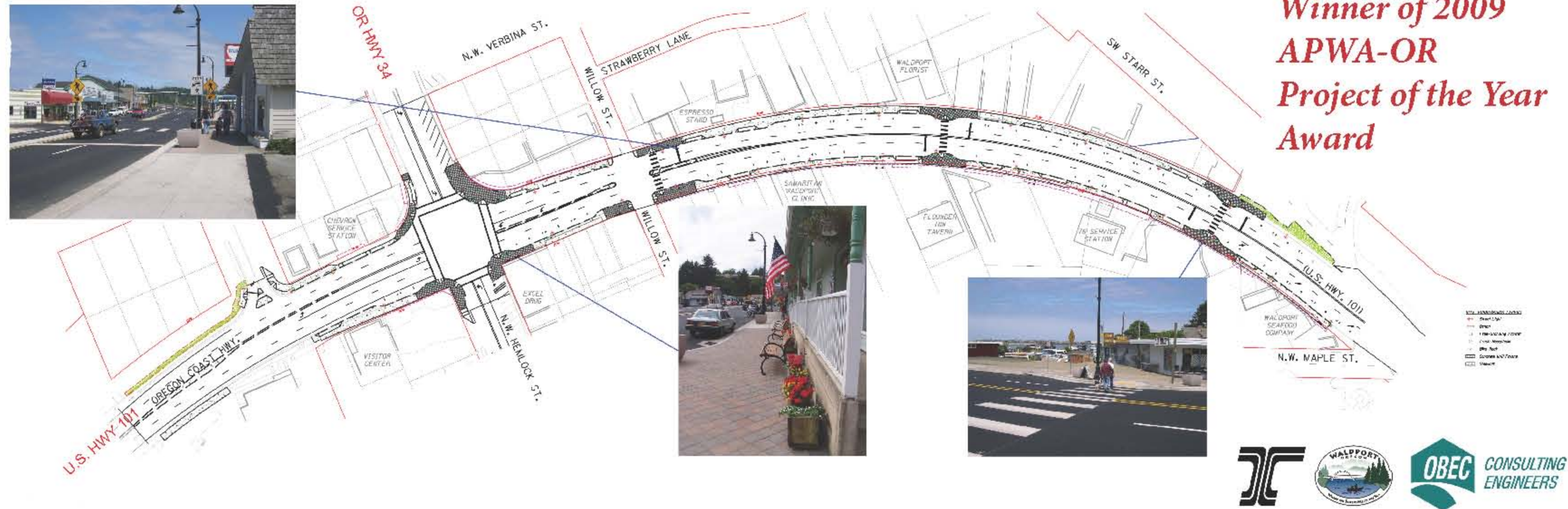


US 101: ALSEA BAY BRIDGE - WILLIAM KEADY WAYSIDE

KEY PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- New streetscape and amenities, including pedestrian lighting, benches, bike racks, decorative planters and waste receptacles
- New, environmentally friendly landscaping
- Converted aerial utility facilities to underground
- New traffic signals at junction of US 101 and OR 34
- Pavement rehabilitation throughout entire project limits
- Updated signing and striping
